
## Ahmedabad - Sasan Gir - Somnath - Junagadh - Rajkot

**Day 1: Ahmedabad/Vadodara:** Arrival at station /Airport, depart for hotel check in refresh a visit to Sardar Patel statue of unity and Overnight stay in Ahmedabad/Vadodara.

**Day 2: Ahmedabad:** Arrival at Ahmedabad, depart for hotel check in refresh and place of visit places like Gandhi Ashram, Jama Masjid, Hutheesinh Jain temple and Adalaj Stepwell and Overnight stay in Ahmedabad.

Day 3: Ahmedabad to Sasan Gir (By Road 350 Kms - 7 Hours): Next day morning after breakfast depart for Sasan gir. Check into the resort and visit the surrounding flaura and fauna. Move out for bird watching in evening before sunset and explore opportunities to spot other mammals and reptiles near your resort in the most natural habitat. Overnight stay in Sasan Gir.



Day 4: Sasangir to Somnath (By Road 50 Kms – 1 Hours): Early morning we shall depart for sasan gir national park for lion safari. Return to the resort around breakfast time. After breakfast we shall depart for somnath. Check into the hotel in somnath and refresh. Visit the somnath temple and later depart for other sightseeing like triveni ghat which is very close to somnath temple and is the meeting point of 3 rivers i.e. "Hiren" "Kapila" & "Saraswati". You can also visit the Bhalka tirth, where Lord Krishna is believed to have renounced his earthly Body. Overnight stay in Somnath.

Day 5 Somnath to Junagadh (By Road 210 Kms – 4.5 Hours): Early morning we shall depart for Junagadh Fort. Junagadh is quite ancient a city in the western Indian state of Gujarat. Mahabat Maqbara is the huge 19th-century mausoleum of a local ruler, which showcases intricate Indo-Islamic architectural details. The Fort founded around 300 BC, has city views from its ramparts. Within the fort are the stone-cut stepwells Adi Kadi Vav and Navghan Kuwo, plus Buddhist caves. To the west, Darbar Hall Museum is housed in a former palace, He laid the foundation of the "Babi Dynasty" that ruled the place till the British declared it as a Princely state and Junagadh opted to accede India during the partition and later move towards Rajkot and check into the hotel and night halt in Rajkot.

**Day 6: Rajkot:** Early morning after breakfast, visit Rotary Doll Museum, Tankara Museum, Lang Library, Watson Museum, Khambhalida Caves. Overnight stay in Rajkot.

Day 7: Rajkot – Ahmedabad (By Road 250 Kms – 4.5 Hours): Early morning after breakfast, we shall go for local sightseeing and depart for station Ahmedabad as per the schedule of Train timing.
